Prov. 22:28

A time where decisive actions were made; a time where time stood still. For many of us, it was these time that changed our lives.

Landmark- mark to designate boundary of land; heap of stones that mark the boundary of a piece of land. A miraculous significant change in our lives- God enabled that landmark to take place. How many times have you had to look back at the landmark and consider the awesomeness of the god we serve? A landmark is a time of great deliverance, regardless of how the world viewed it.

Is. 49:16

Reminder of God forming, moulding me into his image. We are no help to anyone unless we are moulded in to God. We want other to have that freedom and liberty in Christ.

When it was your soul changing experience, God was the one that led you to the altar to repent. It was God that was beginning to work on you, to put you into his kingdom. That day that you were saved, was a day of deliverance, a landmark. Never loose sight of this landmark in your life.
