Loathing the Honeycomb

Bro. Tim (15.7.12pm)

There are some things in the natural world that cannot be made but by God alone. Honey is a natural sweetener, aids in the process of healing, made by hundreds of little insects, tastes goods, and never spoils. Truth is also like honey- it aids in the assistance of healing, good for the body and the soul.

Prov. 16:24

Do you remember how sweet truth was to your life? It mightn't have been what you wanted to hear, but it set you free. The truth made your feel good from your bones out- comes from the inside out when you have the truth within.

Enthusiasm bubbles within you, from your heart. There is a difference between happiness and joy- happiness is for a finite time, but joy comes beyond the defines of time. Joy goes beyond the hard times, and can't be contained within yourself.

Anything that God gives us is good but the world likes to offer a substitute. Honey, sweet, brings a blessing, joy and satisfaction into your body and soul; if you desire the truth, the Lord will give you more. The world offers an artificial sweetener- sweet for a time, poisonous later. If you get hooked on the excitement and thrills of the world, sugar coated pills, then you will hit rock bottom when you come off. There is nothing after the sweetness on the outside wears off.

The Lord offers something that will satisfy the soul, whereas the world offers something sweet, but cant guarantee how long it will last.

Prov. 24:13

Eat the truth because it is good for you. Don't complicate it, or mix anything else with it- truth doesn't spoil. You just need a humble heart, and ask for the truth and the Lord will give it to you.

What do you fill your face with each day? Is it honey or the artificial sweeteners of the world? We need to sup from the Lords table and expect him to move in our lives.

Many years we have been receiving the truth- manna from heaven, clarity, direction, greater understanding, etc. Truth has been everything and anything-

peoples lifeblood. Most people say that truth is number #1, therefore they would be eating manna from heaven, supping from the Lords table.

What flows from your life? What do you live for each week? What do you hold closest and dearest? What consumes you? We can say or answer how ever we like but out of our heart flows what is within.

What is your soul crying out for? Look inside your heart and find the real want of your soul.

Prov. 27:7

Interpretation- A satisfied soul, at the point of boredom, treads down honeycomb. Ask yourself- why do you fellowship here? Wake up your soul, give it a shake, what is it within me want? Has your soul grown plump and bored? If so, you are wasting truth and you don't even realize.

This proverb is a wake up call, we can't rely on past experiences, supping from them for the rest of your life.

Every bitter thing is sweet- every bitter part of truth is sweet to you? Is your soul still hungry? Where is my desire?

When you were first saved, the hunger of your soul drove you to preach, give up different things in your life, but you did all these things because you loved the Lord. To the flesh, it was bitter, but sweet to the soul.

You can be hungry and enthusiastic about what God is doing and will do in those around us.

Num. 13:26

God took care of the Israelites- a fire by night, cloud by day; manna fell from heaven. 12 spies had a look at the land ahead, and reported back to Moses (vs. 32), 10 bringing a pessimistic report but Caleb reported the hope. He was of the minority. He stood out like a sore thumb. Which group do you see with?

Caleb reassures the people that the people ahead were nothing- Num. 14:9. Even though there was 10 that reported the doom and gloom, 2 stood up and said, 'Hey, we were there to and this is what we saw'.

So many people are content coming and going from one congregation to another. They know the truth, spirit and have experienced much in their lives. They are wasting the truth- bring back the hungry soul in your life in your life, your brother or sisters life, the life of someone else.

Mark 5:24-29

She wanted to be touched regardless of how many people were in front of
